Challenge

As Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority (YCUA) transitioned from Kronos Workforce Central to UKG Ready, the organization identified opportunities to further optimize the platform and align it with its operational requirements.

While the core implementation was complete, additional configuration and process enhancements were needed to fully support YCUA's payroll operations, reporting requirements, and day-to-day HR processes. As a public-sector employer with unique payroll rules and reporting obligations, the organization sought experienced guidance to maximize the value of its UKG Ready investment.

Areas requiring additional attention included:

- Extended use of parallel payroll systems
- General ledger configuration impacting payroll and financial reporting
- Configuration across key HR and payroll modules

Employees gained the ability to manage personal information, direct deposits, and benefit elections independently, allowing HR staff to spend less time on routine administrative tasks and more time supporting the organization.
